Chair Report (Cedric Zala):

- We currently have about 300 members. Membership continues to grow.
- Financial health is excellent. Continuing success of the Banff Mountain Film Festival -- sold out this year.
- The newsletter is very successful -- thank you to all, but a special thank you to Lindsey Elms for timely items every month.
- Distinguished Service Award for Peter Rothermel, and Don Forest Award for Mike Hubbard.
- Banquet March 26th, 2010 at McMorran's.
- New concept for summer camps -- suggested by Rick Hudson. Acquire a 14 person dome tent and practice no-trace camping as much as possible. Summer camp is well subscribed.
- In summary the Section appears to be healthy, active, and involved on many fronts.
- Thank you to everyone who has contributed to make this club the success it has become.
- The VI Section's centennial is coming up in two years -- a few ideas are ongoing -- one to digitize and put online all of the old editions of the Bushwhacker (coordinated by Judith Holm).

Treasurer Report (Geoff Bennett):

- Geoff Bennett delivered a PDF presentation. All material is online.
- 2009 was a good year on the monetary front. Revenues over \$16,666.00.
- Expenses in 2009 were \$13,306.00.
- In 2010 the Club will spend more than it takes in.
- We will charge users \$20.00 per trip for the summer camp, and other uses of this tent-this will have us paying for the tent in three years.
- In 2010 we will have budged expenses of \$21,655. We will spend \$5500.00 in education subsidies. The Section will be subsidizing education events -- like first aid courses (for example).
- We will print at least 70 more Bushwhackers than usual -- one for every new member, and approx 20 for UVic Outdoors Club members.

Education Report (Dave Campbell):

• A number of educational courses and events are being offered -- wide range of events with many different topics covered at many different levels. Thank you to everyone that has helped out. Announcements for education events are on the website, and in the newsletter.

Membership Report (Tim Turay, for Jain Alcock-White):

- Membership appears to be increasing. There appears to be some inconsistency with our numbers and the National organization's numbers.
- Membership as of Dec 31 2008: 238 individuals, 58 partners, 354 people (??)
- Membership as of Dec 31, 2009: 256 individuals, 29 partners, 374 people (??)
- Problem -- as of Jan 20, 2009 there were 195 individuals, 59 partners, total: 313 people (??)
- Strictly according to year end membership numbers, the increase is 20 people. However, according to new, renewed, and lapsed -- it doesn't add up. The Membership Secretary cannot determine why this is. **Geoff** noted that he will be in touch with Jain to see if they can resolve the issue around getting accurate membership numbers from the National office.

FMCBC Report (Peter Rothermel):

- The FMCMC is there for its members (including all ACC members) and ACC members are encouraged to get involved.
- Money has been getting short, but this year is the first year FMCBC has started to save a bit of money.
- There is some possibility to reduce the money paid to FMCBC, but FMCBC is making a number of economies -- consider leaving the money given over to FMCBC the same.
